A value of 31 0.3 full-time equivalent student membership shall be calculated 32 for each student who receives an International Baccalaureate diploma. Such value shall be added to the total full-time 33 34 equivalent student membership in basic programs for grades 9 through 12 in the subsequent fiscal year. Each school district 35 36 shall allocate 80 percent of the funds received from 37 International Baccalaureate bonus FTE funding to the school program whose students generate the funds and to school programs 38 39 that prepare prospective students to enroll in International 40 Baccalaureate courses. Funds shall be expended solely for the payment of allowable costs associated with the International 41 42 Baccalaureate program.
