Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 775.37, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 775.37 Veterans with mental health conditions; modification of sentence.—
- (1) As used in this section, the term "modified sentence" means a sentence below the required specified term of imprisonment or mandatory minimum term, and may include a waiver of restrictions on the defendant's eligibility for gain-time or release.
- (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, when a defendant has been convicted of an offense that requires the imposition of a specified term of imprisonment or mandatory

27	modified sentence if the court finds on the record that:

33	sentenced for an offense enumerated in s. 943.0435(1)(h)1.a.(I).
