1 House Resolution 2 A resolution expressing appreciation for the sister-3 state relationship and bilateral economic and cultural ties between the State of Florida and Taiwan. 4 5 6 WHEREAS, the Taiwan Relations Act was signed in 1979, which 7 codified into law the basis for continuous commercial and 8 cultural relations between the people of the United States and 9 Taiwan, and 10 WHEREAS, the new administration of Taiwan began promoting 11 integrated diplomacy as proposed by President Lai Ching-te, 12 which demonstrates that Taiwan is a pivotal force for stability 13 and prosperity in the Indo-Pacific, and 14 WHEREAS, after Hurricane Helene and Hurricane Milton tore through Florida in September and October 2024, respectively, 15 impacting vast areas and causing casualties and damage, the 16 17 Government of Taiwan donated \$300,000 through the Taipei 18 Economic and Culture Office in Miami to the Florida Disaster 19 Fund, and 20 WHEREAS, Taiwan is the United States' seventh largest 21 trading partner, as well as Florida's fourth largest bilateral 22 merchandise trading partner in the Asia-Pacific region, and 23 WHEREAS, the economy of Taiwan benefited by the rising 24 global demand for high-performance computing and artificial

25 intelligence and reached a growth rate higher than 4 percent in 26 2024, and

27 WHEREAS, a Florida high-tech delegation led by 28 SelectFlorida visited Taiwan in May 2024 to explore the 29 feasibility of Taiwan-Florida semiconductor industry 30 cooperation, successfully establishing a further connection 31 between Taiwan and Florida, and

32 WHEREAS, Taiwan and Florida signed a Memorandum of 33 Understanding on Economic and Trade Cooperation on January 9, 34 2025, embodying the determination by both countries to advance 35 toward a stronger partnership on mutual trade, industry, and 36 investment activities, and

37 WHEREAS, in November 2024, the Taiwanese Chambers of 38 Commerce of North America held its annual meeting in Fort 39 Lauderdale, which was attended by more than 500 global 40 delegates, indicating that Florida's role as a hub for trade and 41 investment in the Western Hemisphere has been widely recognized, 42 and

WHEREAS, since November 1, 2012, Taiwan has been a member of the United States Visa Waiver Program, which enhances the convenience of two-way travel for business and tourism, reflecting the cooperation between the United States and Taiwan, and

WHEREAS, the launch of FORMOSAT-7/COSMIC-2 on June 25,
2019, a joint United States-Taiwan collaborative space mission

50 of a constellation of six satellites designed to enhance the 51 accuracy of atmospheric weather prediction, has demonstrated the 52 mutual benefit born from the relations between Florida and 53 Taiwan, and

54 WHEREAS, Taiwan actively participates in international 55 organizations, including the World Health Assembly, the United 56 Nations, the International Criminal Police Organization, and the 57 United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, while also maintaining its membership status in both the Asia-Pacific 58 59 Economic Cooperation and the World Trade Organization, and 60 participating, observing, and cooperating with more than 50 61 additional international organizations, and

62 WHEREAS, the economic bonds between the United States and 63 Taiwan continue to flourish, which were embodied in the signing of the United States-Taiwan Initiative on 21st-Century Trade 64 65 First Agreement Implementation Act in August 2023, in the 66 extension of the Economic Prosperity Partnership Dialogue 67 Memorandum of Understanding for an additional 5 years, in Taiwan's inclusion in the Indo-Pacific Economic Framework, and 68 69 in the negotiation of the United States-Taiwan Agreement of 70 Avoidance of Double Taxation, and

71 WHEREAS, since the establishment of the Taipei Economic and 72 Cultural Office in Miami 1988, Taiwan has developed multiple 73 sister-city relationships in the state, and is proud to have a
