5	WHEREAS, colorectal cancer is currently the second most
6	common cause of cancer deaths among men and women in the United
7	States when the numbers are combined, and
8	WHEREAS, according to estimates from the American Cancer
9	Society, 154,270 people will be diagnosed with colorectal cancer
10	and 52,900 deaths will occur from colorectal cancer in the
11	United States in 2025, and
12	WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society estimates there will
13	be 107,320 new cases of colon cancer and 46,950 new cases of
14	rectal cancer in the United States in 2025, and
15	WHEREAS, according to the Department of Health, when
16	adjusted for age, there were 11,243 colorectal cancer incidences
17	per 100,000 Floridians in 2021, and
18	WHEREAS, regular screening beginning at the age of 45 may
19	detect colorectal cancer in its earlier stages and increase
20	colorectal cancer survival rates, and
21	WHEREAS, increasing awareness and education concerning
22	colorectal cancer can lead to significant progress in both
23	preventing and overcoming the disease, as the majority of cases
24	have proven to be both treatable and survivable, and
