7	WHEREAS, the State of Florida and Japan share a rapidly
8	growing political and economic relationship, characterized by
9	mutual benefits that contribute to the continued partnership
10	between the two regions, and
11	WHEREAS, the historic ties between Florida and Japan date
12	back to the early 20th century, beginning with the settlement of
13	the Yamato Colony by Japanese immigrants in Delray Beach, which
14	is now the renowned Morikami Museum and Japanese Garden, and
15	WHEREAS, despite ups and downs in economic relations over
16	the years, today Japan is Florida's second largest source of
17	imports and a significant investor in the state's economy and is
18	the largest source of foreign investment in the United States,
19	and
20	WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis, leading a high-profile
21	trade mission, visited Japan in April 2023, reinforcing
22	diplomatic and economic dialogues between Florida and Japanese
23	officials and business leaders, and
24	WHEREAS, in October 2023, Florida hosted another successful
25	trade mission to Japan, during which Secretary of State Cord

26 Byrd and Japan's Parliamentary Vice Minister for Foreign Affairs 27 Masahiro Komura signed a Memorandum of Cooperation to enhance 28 economic and trade collaboration between the two regions, and WHEREAS, in December 2023, Miami-Dade County Mayor Daniella 29 30 Levine Cava led a trade mission to Japan, culminating in the 31 signing of a Sister Port Agreement between Port of Miami and the 32 Port of Yokohama, further solidifying the maritime and economic 33 connections between the two regions, and 34 WHEREAS, these recent exchanges and agreements underscore 35 the accelerating momentum in Florida-Japan relations, 36 highlighting the significant strides made in business, trade, 37 and cultural cooperation over the past year, and WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature recognizes the political, 38 39 economic, and cultural ties between Florida and Japan, ensuring 40 continued collaboration and fostering long-term benefits for 41 both regions, NOW, THEREFORE, 42 43 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida: 44 45 That the House of Representatives recognizes the importance 46 of Japanese business, trade, and cultural cooperation with the 47 48 State of Florida and the diplomatic, cultural, and business ties 49 with Japan.
