2	A resolution designating April 2025 as "Limb
3	Difference and Limb Loss Awareness Month" in Florida.

5	WHEREAS, there are approximately 2.1 million Americans
6	living with limb loss and limb difference, and
7	WHEREAS, approximately 1,900 children are born each year in
8	the United States with congenital limb difference, and
9	WHEREAS, diabetes, peripheral vascular disease, and trauma
10	are cited as the leading causes of amputation, and
11	WHEREAS, over 500 Americans lose a limb every day, with
12	nearly 12,000 amputations performed in Florida each year, and
13	WHEREAS, integrated data from the United States Department
14	of Veterans Affairs and the United States Department of Defense
15	shows that traumatic amputations account for less than half of
16	one percent of the veteran population; however, research reveals
17	that after leaving military service, over 80 percent of amputees
18	have diagnoses of mental disorders, diseases of the nervous
19	system and organs, and diseases of the musculoskeletal system
20	and connective tissue in addition to their injury, and
21	WHEREAS, emotional, physical, social, and financial stress
22	often plague those with limb difference or limb loss, and
23	WHEREAS, access to appropriate prosthetic care for people
24	living with limb loss and limb difference is vital to enable

26	and live well, and
27	WHEREAS, April is an appropriate month to designate as Limb
28	Difference and Limb Loss Awareness Month as spring is a time of
29	renewal and inspiration, NOW, THEREFORE,
