8	Vietnam War, with more than 58,000 making the ultimate
9	sacrifice, more than 303,000 wounded, and over 1,573 still
10	unaccounted for, and
11	WHEREAS, Florida is home to more than 439,000 Vietnam-era
12	veterans, making it home to the largest population of Vietnam-
13	era veterans in the nation, and
14	WHEREAS, Florida was home to 87 military members classified
15	as POW/MIA during the Vietnam War, 34 of whom were repatriated
16	and 53 who are still MIA, and
17	WHEREAS, the POW/MIA flag is flown daily over the Florida
18	Capitol, at rest areas along Florida's interstate highways, at
19	Florida's state parks, and over the state's network of veterans'
20	homes to honor those classified as prisoners of war or missing
21	in action, and
22	WHEREAS, Jacksonville is home to the National POW/MIA
23	Memorial and Museum, and
