26 member's initial benefit plus an amount equal to a percentage of 27 the member's initial benefit. This percentage is derived by 28 dividing the number of months the member has received an initial 29 benefit by 12, and multiplying the result by the factor 30 calculated pursuant to paragraph (c).

(b) For those retirees and annuitants who have received a cost-of-living adjustment under this subsection, the adjusted monthly benefit shall be the amount of the monthly benefit being received on June 30 immediately preceding the adjustment date plus an amount determined by multiplying the benefit by the factor calculated pursuant to paragraph (c).

(c) The department shall calculate a cost-of-living factor for each retiree and beneficiary retiring on or after July 1, 2011. This factor shall equal the product of 3 percent multiplied by the quotient of the sum of the member's service credit earned for service before July 1, 2011, divided by the sum of the member's total service credit earned. <u>Effective July</u> 1, 2025, this factor may not be below 2 percent.
