

1                   A bill to be entitled  
 2           An act relating to arrest warrants for state  
 3           prisoners; creating s. 944.085, F.S.; authorizing a  
 4           prisoner in a state prison who has an unserved warrant  
 5           to file a notice of unserved warrant in the circuit  
 6           court in which the warrant was issued; requiring the  
 7           prisoner to serve notice on the state attorney;  
 8           requiring the circuit court to schedule a status  
 9           hearing within a certain time after receiving notice;  
 10          specifying procedures and requirements for the status  
 11          hearing; requiring the court to send an order to the  
 12          county sheriff; providing an effective date.

 14 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 16           **Section 1. Section 944.085, Florida Statutes, is created**  
 17 **to read:**

18           944.085 Unserved warrants of state prisoners.—

19           (1) A prisoner in a state prison who has an unserved  
 20 warrant for his or her arrest in this state may file a state  
 21 prisoner's notice of unserved warrant in the circuit court of  
 22 the judicial circuit in which the unserved warrant was issued.

23           (2) The prisoner must serve notice upon the state attorney  
 24 of the circuit. The circuit court shall schedule the notice for  
 25 a status hearing within 90 days after receipt of the notice. The

26 | state prisoner may not be transported to the status hearing. At  
27 | the status hearing, the state attorney shall inform the court as  
28 | to whether there is an unserved warrant for the arrest of the  
29 | state prisoner.

30 | (3) If a warrant exists, the court must enter an order  
31 | within 30 days after the status hearing for the transport of the  
32 | state prisoner to the county jail of the county that issued the  
33 | warrant and the court shall send the order to the county sheriff  
34 | for execution.

35 | **Section 2.** This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
