The license is nontransferable. A copy of the license 23 shall be displayed in a conspicuous place. Except as provided in 24 paragraph (k), the license is valid for 1 year from the date of 25 issuance, unless the license is suspended or revoked by the 26 department or is voluntarily surrendered by the licensee. The 27 license is the property of the department.

The department shall adopt rules to ensure that a</u> 29 <u>licensee who moves to another location within this state may</u> 30 <u>amend his or her current license without the need to submit a</u> 31 <u>new application for licensure and that the amended license</u> 32 process receives priority.
