A bill to be entitled

An act relating to sales tax exemption for disabled veterans; amending s. 212.08, F.S.; creating an exemption from specified taxes on sales made to certain veterans; requiring a person seeking an exemption to apply to the Department of Revenue using a certain form and submit supporting documentation as required by the department; requiring the department to adopt rules; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (20) is added to section 212.08, Florida Statutes, to read:

212.08 Sales, rental, use, consumption, distribution, and storage tax; specified exemptions.—The sale at retail, the rental, the use, the consumption, the distribution, and the storage to be used or consumed in this state of the following are hereby specifically exempt from the tax imposed by this chapter.

## (20) EXEMPTIONS; VETERANS.—

(a) There are exempt from the tax imposed by this chapter sales made to a disabled veteran with a service-connected disability rating of 100 percent.

(b) To be eligible for an exemption under this subsection, the person seeking the exemption must apply to the department for a tax exemption certificate using a form prescribed by the department and must submit supporting documentation as required by the department.
