- (b) A person may not knowingly and intentionally disclose information in work products made confidential and exempt from s. 119.071(1) pursuant to s. 110.201(4) or s. 447.605(3), unless such person is specifically authorized by the chief executive officer or the legislative body of the public employer to disclose such information.
- (3) A person who knowingly receives information in violation of subsection (2) must refer the person who provided such information to the commission pursuant to s. 112.324.
