**Amendment to Amendment (019831) by Representative Black
(with title amendment)**

Between lines 239 and 240 of the amendment, insert:

**Section 3. Section 683.38, Florida Statutes, is created to
read:**

683.38 Black History Month.—

(1) Local governments may recognize the month of February
as Black History Month, in addition to any other state
recognized holiday.

(2) The Legislature hereby designates the month of
February as Black History Month.

(3) The Governor may issue a proclamation annually designating the month of February as Black History Month and calling upon citizens of the state to observe the occasion.

Remove line 286 of the amendment and insert:
applicability; creating s. 683.38, F.S.; allowing
local governments to designate the month of February
as Black History Month; designating the month of
February as Black History Month for the state;
authorizing the Governor to issue a proclamation
annually related to the recognition of the month of
