Remove lines 167-173 and insert:

(3) All instructional materials, curriculum content, and programs funded in whole or in part with state or federal funds must be presented in a neutral, fact-based, nonadvocacy manner. Such materials and programs may not include explicit political messaging, calls to civic or political action, or the promotion or endorsement of a specific political ideology or partisan viewpoint.

(4) Subsection (2) does not prohibit programs, campus activities, or functions required for compliance with general or

15 accreditation and for continuing to receive state funds with the
