6 Between lines 209 and 210, insert:

7 **Section 3. Subsection (4) of section 1002.32, Florida**

8 **Statutes, is amended to read:**

9 1002.32 Developmental research (laboratory) schools.—

10 (4) STUDENT ADMISSIONS.—Each lab school may establish a
11 primary research objective related to fundamental issues and
12 problems that occur in the public elementary and secondary
13 schools of the state. Admissions criteria should reflect an
emphasis on student merit and achievement with no regard to
race, sex, creed, color, or national origin. Lab schools may not
use racial or sex set-asides, preferences, or quotas in their

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17 admissions process. A student population reflective of the
18 student population of the public school environment in which the
19 issues and problems are most prevalent shall be promoted and
20 encouraged through the establishment and implementation of an
21 admission process that is designed to result in a representative
22 sample of public school enrollment based on gender, race,
23 socioeconomic status, and academic ability, notwithstanding the
24 provisions of s. 1000.05.
