Representative Hodgers offered the following:

Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 40-49 and insert:

a diploma from a Florida high school in which the applicant
completed the insurance and personal finance course provided in
s. 1003.4207; or a degree from an accredited institution of
higher learning approved by the department when the degree
includes a minimum of 9 credit hours of insurance instruction,
including specific instruction in the areas of property,
casualty, and inland marine insurance. The department shall
adopt rules establishing standards for the approval of
curriculum.

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Section 2. Section 1003.4207, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1003.4207 Insurance and personal finance course.—No later than January 1, 2027, the Department of Education, in consultation with the Department of Financial Services, shall develop a 0.5 credit course in insurance and personal finance which is available to school districts for use beginning with the 2027-2028 school year. The course must include a comprehensive analysis of basic property and casualty lines of insurance consistent with the instructional designations provided under s. 626.7351(3).
