Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

providing penalties; providing an effective date.

## Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 775.085, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

775.085 Evidencing prejudice while committing offense; reclassification.-

- (1) (a) The penalty for any felony or misdemeanor shall be reclassified as provided in this subsection if the commission of such felony or misdemeanor evidences prejudice based on the race, color, ancestry, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, homeless status, or advanced age, or political ideology of the victim:
- A misdemeanor of the second degree is reclassified to a misdemeanor of the first degree.
- 2. A misdemeanor of the first degree is reclassified to a felony of the third degree.
- 3. A felony of the third degree is reclassified to a felony of the second degree.
