39 registered nurse who diagnoses or treats a patient for
40 Parkinson's disease shall report to the statewide Parkinson's
41 disease registry, established pursuant to s. 1004.4352,

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42 information containing nationally recognized Parkinson's disease
43 performance measures.

44 (2) A liability of any kind or character for damages or
45 other relief may not arise or be enforced against a physician by
46 reason of having provided such information to the statewide

48 **Section 4. Paragraphs (b) and (e) of subsection (4) of**
49 **section 1004.4352, Florida Statutes, are amended and subsection**

52 (4) CONSORTIUM FOR PARKINSON'S DISEASE RESEARCH.—

53 (b) The Parkinson's Disease Research Board is established
54 to direct the operations of the consortium. The board shall be
55 composed of one member appointed by the President of the Senate,
56 one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of
57 Representatives and, members representing each participating
58 university or academic medical center, appointed by the
59 president or chief executive officer of each participating
60 university or academic medical center. Board members, other than
61 those appointed by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of
62 the House of Representatives, must have experience as a movement
63 disorder specialist, informatics or population health research,
64 and Parkinson's disease researchers in a variety of scientific
65 fields, including, but not limited to, neurology, psychology,
66 nutrition, and genetics. Members shall be appointed to 34-year

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67 terms and may be reappointed to serve additional terms. The
68 chair shall be elected by the board from among its members to
69 serve a 2-year term. The board shall meet at least semiannually
70 at the call of the chair or, in his or her absence or
71 incapacity, the vice chair. Four members constitute a quorum. A
72 majority vote of the members present is required for all actions
73 of the board. The board may prescribe, amend, and repeal a
74 charter governing the manner in which it conducts its business.
75 Board members shall serve without compensation, but are entitled
76 to receive reimbursement for travel expenses by the consortium
77 or the organization he or she represents in accordance with s.
78 112.061.

79 (e) By October 15 of each year, the board shall issue a
80 report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the
81 Speaker of the House of Representatives on research projects,
82 research findings, community outreach initiatives conducted or
83 funded by ~~, and future plans for the consortium. Beginning on~~
84 October 15, 2028, and annually thereafter, the report shall
85 include a summary update on the incident and prevalence of
86 Parkinson's disease in the state by county, how many records
87 have been included and reported into the registry, and
88 demographic information such as patients by age, gender and
89 race.

91 (a) Subject to a specific appropriation, the Florida

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92 Institute for Parkinson's Disease within the University of South
93 Florida shall establish and maintain a statewide Parkinson's
94 disease registry to ensure that the Parkinson's disease
95 performance measures required to be submitted under paragraph
96 (b) are maintained and available for use to improve or modify
97 the Parkinson's disease care system, ensure compliance with
98 standards and nationally recognized guidelines, and monitor
99 Parkinson's disease patient outcomes.

100 (b) Physicians licensed under chapter 458 or chapter 459,
101 pursuant to ss. 458.352 and 459.075, and advanced practice
102 registered nurses, pursuant to s. 464.0145, shall report to the
103 statewide Parkinson's disease registry information containing
104 nationally recognized Parkinson's disease performance measures.

105 c) Beginning January 1, 2028, the Institute for Parkinson's
106 Disease within the University of South Florida shall create and
107 maintain a public webpage dedicated solely to the Parkinson's
108 Disease Registry which must include, at a minimum, downloadable
109 annual reports on the incidence and prevalence of Parkinson's
110 disease, information on the Advisory Committee, and other
111 information as determined by the board. The webpage shall be
112 updated on or before January 1, 2029 and every year thereafter.

113 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
