9 on October 2, 2031, unless reviewed and saved from repeal
10 through reenactment by the Legislature.

11 Section 2. The Legislature finds that is a public
12 necessity that information held in the Parkinson's disease
13 registry under s. 1004.4352, Florida Statutes, which would
14 identify a patient be made confidential and exempt from s.
15 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the

18 personal privacy of the individual identified in the registry.
19 Furthermore, the disclosure of such information could hinder the
20 effective and efficient administration of the registry. Finally,
21 access to such information could be used to solicit or harass an
22 individual identified in the registry. Thus, the Legislature
23 finds that information held in the Parkinson's disease registry
24 which would identify a patient should be confidential and exempt
25 from public records requirements.
