Section 1. Section 15.0352, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

(1) The American flamingo (*Phoenicopterus ruber*) is designated the official Florida state bird.

Section 2. The designation of the American flamingo as the official Florida state bird and the Florida scrub-jay as the official Florida state songbird by s. 15.0352, Florida Statutes, supersedes the designation of the mockingbird as the official Florida state bird by Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 3, adopted during the 1927 Regular Session.
