A bill to be entitled

An act relating to motor vehicle racing penalties;  
amending s. 316.191, F.S.; increasing penalties for  
violations of the prohibition against coordinating  
through social media or otherwise or facilitating a  
prohibited race, a drag race, a street takeover, stunt  
driving, a competition, a contest, a test, or an  
exhibition; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section  
316.191, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.191 Racing on highways, street takeovers, and stunt  
driving.—

(3)(a) A Any person who violates subsection (2) commits a  
misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s.  
775.082 or s. 775.083, and must. ~~Any person who violates~~  
~~subsection (2) shall~~ pay a fine of not less than \$500 and not  
more than \$2,000, except that a person who in any manner  
coordinates through social media or otherwise or who facilitates  
a race, a drag race, a street takeover, stunt driving, a  
competition, a contest, a test, or an exhibition in violation of  
paragraph (2)(b) commits a felony of the third degree,  
punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, and must pay  
a fine of not less than \$2,500 and not more than \$4,000. ~~and~~ The  
department shall revoke the driver license of a person so  
convicted for 1 year. A hearing may be requested pursuant to s.  
322.271.
