Remove lines 32-44 and insert:

(2) In a products liability action involving a firearm which is based on a theory of defective product design, negligence, or strict liability based on the absence or presence of any design feature, functionality, safety mechanism, or performance standard that is not required by federal law as a condition for the lawful manufacture, sale, import, or receipt of the firearm, including, but not limited to:

(a) A magazine disconnect mechanism;

(b) A loaded chamber indicator;
