A bill to be entitled
An act relating to specialty license plates; amending
s. 320.08058, F.S.; directing the Department of
Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop an
Outsider license plate; providing for distribution and
use of fees collected from the sale of the plate;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (136) is added to section 320.08058,
Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08058 Specialty license plates.—

(136) OUTSIDER LICENSE PLATES.—

(a) The department shall develop an Outsider license plate
as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate must
bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word
"Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the word
"OUTSIDER" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

(b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate must be
distributed to the Hooper Brothers Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit
corporation under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code,
which may use up to 10 percent of the proceeds for
administrative costs and marketing of the plate. The Hooper
Brothers Foundation, Inc., shall use the remainder of the
proceeds to create and restore iconic public destinations across
this state.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2026.
