A resolution recognizing February 17, 2026, as "Florida Polytechnic University Day" in Florida.

WHEREAS, spanning a 170-acre campus in Lakeland, Florida Polytechnic University has 14 undergraduate and 5 graduate programs, and provides a world-class academic environment through its innovative curriculum, undergraduate research opportunities, and interdisciplinary programs that prepare students for success in a global economy, and

WHEREAS, Florida Polytechnic University has been ranked the No. 1 public college in the South for 5 years running by *U.S. News & World Report*, which also ranks the University among the top 30 nationally for public engineering programs without a Ph.D., and

WHEREAS, according to Research.com, Florida Polytechnic University has the No. 1 computer science program in Florida among public universities, and its data science program is ranked among the top 20 in the United States, and

WHEREAS, Florida Polytechnic University's graduates consistently achieve high job placement rates and competitive starting salaries in such critical fields as cybersecurity, advanced manufacturing, robotics, engineering, and data science, contributing directly to Florida's growing technology economy,
