Remove lines 39-52 and insert:
employs 50 or more employees.

(b) "Living organ donor" means a person who donates all or
part of a human organ while he or she is alive for
transplantation into another person.

(2)(a) An employer shall grant an employee an unpaid leave
of absence to allow the employee to serve as a living organ
donor if the employee submits a written request for such leave,
including written documentation from the attending physician
confirming the date of the donation. The leave shall continue

16 until the attending physician provides medical clearance for the
17 employee to resume work duties.

18 (b) The unpaid leave of absence granted pursuant to
19 paragraph (a) is in addition to any medical, personal, or other
20 paid leave provided by the employer.
