An act relating to special protections in judicial proceedings; amending s. 92.55, F.S.; requiring a pro se defendant to question certain victims and witnesses through standby counsel at any trial, hearing, or deposition; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Subsection (7) is added to section 92.55, Section 1. Florida Statutes, to read:

- 92.55 Special protections in proceedings involving victim or witness under 18, person with intellectual disability, or sexual offense victim.-
- Upon motion of any party, upon motion of a parent, guardian, attorney, guardian ad litem, or other advocate appointed by the court under s. 914.17 for a victim or witness under the age of 18, a person who has an intellectual disability, or a sexual offense victim or witness, or upon its own motion, the court shall require a pro se defendant to present, ask, or in any way communicate questions to such person, victim, or witness through standby counsel at any trial, hearing, or deposition.
 - This act shall take effect July 1, 2026. Section 2.
