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13 **Section 1.** Part IV of chapter 760, Florida Statutes,
14 consisting of s. 760.80, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

15 **Section 2.** Part V of chapter 760, Florida Statutes,
16 consisting of s. 760.854, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

17 **Section 3. Paragraph (k) of subsection (1) of section**
18 **1001.216, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

19 1001.216 Council on the Social Status of Black Men and
20 Boys.—

21 (1) The Council on the Social Status of Black Men and Boys
22 is established within Florida Memorial University and shall be
23 composed of 19 members appointed as follows:

24 (k) A businessperson who is an African American, ~~as~~
