Between lines 11145 and 11146, insert:

(16) APPLICABILITY TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS NOT LISTED AS A
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE.—

(a) An establishment at which prescription drugs not
listed as a controlled substance, as defined in s. 893.03, are
stored, warehoused, or held, solely for the purpose of arranging
for their destruction, is not required to comply with paragraph
(1)(c); subsections (3)-(6); paragraphs (8)(a), (b), and (d);
and subsection (13).

(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), an establishment at
which prescription drugs not listed as a controlled substance,

17 as defined in s. 893.03, are stored, warehoused, or held, solely
18 for the purpose of arranging for their destruction must maintain
19 the following records:

20 1. The business name, and address from which the
21 prescription drugs were collected.

22 2. A list of the prescription drugs.

23 3. The amount, or, if adulterated or altered prior to
24 collection, an estimate of the amount, of the prescription drugs
25 collected.

26 4. The manner, date, and location of destruction of the
27 prescription drugs.

28 (c) Records required to be kept pursuant to paragraph (b),
29 which are kept at the establishment or can be immediately
30 retrieved by computer or other electronic means, must be readily
31 available for authorized inspection pursuant to this section. If
32 such records are not available upon request, the records must be
33 made available for authorized inspection within 2 business days
34 after the request. Records kept at a central location outside of
35 this state which are not electronically retrievable must be made
36 available for inspection within 5 business days after a request.

37 (d) Records required to be kept pursuant to paragraph (b)
38 must be maintained for a period of not less than 5 years from
39 the date of destruction of the prescription drugs.

such records to be maintained for a specified time
period;
