- (c) Records required to be kept pursuant to paragraph (b), which are kept at the establishment or can be immediately retrieved by computer or other electronic means, must be readily available for authorized inspection pursuant to this section. If such records are not available upon request, the records must be made available for authorized inspection within 2 business days after the request. Records kept at a central location outside of this state which are not electronically retrievable must be made available for inspection within 5 business days after a request.
- (d) Records required to be kept pursuant to paragraph (b) must be maintained for a period of not less than 5 years from the date of destruction of the prescription drugs.
