8 related service identified in a student's IEP as scheduled, the
9 school administrator or staffing specialist must notify the
10 parent in writing within 5 school days, explain the reason the
11 service was not provided, and provide a written plan for make-up
12 services.

13 5. A parent has the right to access, upon request, all
14 service logs within 15 school days after such service is
15 provided. The IEP team must inform parents of this right at each
16 IEP meeting.
