15 **Section 4. Paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section**  
16 **105.031, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

17 105.031 Qualification; filing fee; candidate's oath; items  
18 required to be filed.—

19 (5) ITEMS REQUIRED TO BE FILED.—

20 (a) In order for a candidate for judicial office or the  
21 office of school board member to be qualified, the following  
22 items must be received by the filing officer by the end of the  
23 qualifying period:

24 1. Except for candidates for retention to judicial office,  
25 a properly executed check drawn upon the candidate's campaign  
26 account in an amount not less than the fee required by  
27 subsection (3) or, in lieu thereof, the copy of the notice of  
28 obtaining ballot position pursuant to s. 105.035. If a  
29 candidate's check is returned by the bank for any reason, the  
30 filing officer shall immediately notify the candidate and the  
31 candidate shall, the end of qualifying notwithstanding, have 48  
32 hours from the time such notification is received, excluding  
33 Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, to pay the fee with a  
34 cashier's check purchased from funds of the campaign account.  
35 Failure to pay the fee as provided in this subparagraph shall  
36 disqualify the candidate.

62           5. The full and public disclosure of financial interests  
63 required by s. 8, Art. II of the State Constitution or the  
64 statement of financial interests required by s. 112.3145,  
65 whichever is applicable. A public officer who has filed the full  
66 and public disclosure or statement of financial interests with  
67 the Commission on Ethics or the supervisor of elections prior to  
68 qualifying for office may file a copy of that disclosure at the  
69 time of qualifying.
