17 **Section 4. Paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section**
18 **105.031, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

19 105.031 Qualification; filing fee; candidate's oath; items
20 required to be filed.—

21 (5) ITEMS REQUIRED TO BE FILED.—

22 (a) In order for a candidate for judicial office or the
23 office of school board member to be qualified, the following
24 items must be received by the filing officer by the end of the
25 qualifying period:

26 1. Except for candidates for retention to judicial office,
27 a properly executed check drawn upon the candidate's campaign
28 account in an amount not less than the fee required by
29 subsection (3) or, in lieu thereof, the copy of the notice of
30 obtaining ballot position pursuant to s. 105.035. If a
31 candidate's check is returned by the bank for any reason, the
32 filing officer shall immediately notify the candidate and the
33 candidate shall, the end of qualifying notwithstanding, have 48
34 hours from the time such notification is received, excluding
35 Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, to pay the fee with a
36 cashier's check purchased from funds of the campaign account.
37 Failure to pay the fee as provided in this subparagraph shall
38 disqualify the candidate.
