Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 468.8313, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

468.8313 Examinations.—

(4) The department may review and approve <u>national</u> examinations <u>and state examinations that otherwise meet the generally accepted testing standards criteria of national examinations that the department has certified under s.

455.217(1)(d) by a nationally recognized entity that offers programs or sets standards that ensure competence as a home inspector.</u>

Section 2. Section 468.8322, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

468.8322 Insurance.—A home inspector shall maintain a commercial general liability insurance policy and an errors and

omissions insurance policy in an amount of at least not less than \$300,000 per policy.
