Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Section 491.019, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
- 491.019 Licensure by endorsement; marriage and family therapists.-The board shall issue a license to practice marriage and family therapy to an applicant who meets all of the following criteria:
 - (1) Submits a complete application.

providing an effective date.

- (2) Submits the required application fee.
- (3) Holds an active, unencumbered marriage and family therapy license in good standing issued by another state, the District of Columbia, or a territory of the United States, and provides proof of all mental health licenses held in any other jurisdiction.
- (4) Attests that he or she is not, at the time of submission of the application, the subject of a disciplinary proceeding in a jurisdiction in which he or she holds a license for reasons related to the practice of marriage and family therapy.
 - (5) Has not had disciplinary action taken against him or
