- (2) A local governmental entity may not enact any rule, regulation, or ordinance regarding the use, disposition, sale, prohibition, or restriction of drinking straws or stirrers which does not meet the requirements of this section. By January 1, 2027, a local governmental entity shall amend any such rule, regulation, or ordinance in effect as of the effective date of this act which does not permit the sale or use of drinking straws and stirrers that are renewable, home compostable certified, industrial compostable certified, or marine biodegradable to permit the sale or use of renewable, home compostable certified, industrial compostable certified and marine biodegradable drinking straws and stirrers.
- (3) If a local governmental entity elects to enact any rule, regulation, or ordinance regarding the use, disposition, sale, prohibition, or restriction of drinking straws or stirrers, such rule, regulation, or ordinance must require that drinking straws or stirrers be:
 - (a) Renewable;
