

A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to medical marijuana use registry  
identification cards for veterans; amending s.  
381.986, F.S.; authorizing the Department of Health to  
charge a reduced fee for the issuance, replacement, or  
renewal of an identification card for an honorably  
discharged veteran; providing requirements for proof  
of identification; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

**Section 1. Paragraph (f) is added to subsection (7) of  
section 381.986, Florida Statutes, to read:**

381.986 Medical use of marijuana.—

(7) IDENTIFICATION CARDS.—

(f) The department shall charge a reduced fee of \$15 for  
the issuance, replacement, or renewal of an identification card  
for a qualified patient who is a veteran, as defined in s.  
1.01(14), if the application includes a copy of any of the  
following as proof of veteran status:

1. A DD-214 form;

2. A Department of Veterans Affairs identification card or  
a Uniformed Services identification card indicating retired  
status; or

3. A Florida driver license bearing the veteran
