A bill to be entitled

An act relating to veterinary prescription disclosure; creating s. 474.224, F.S.; requiring a veterinarian to inform a client of the right to receive a written prescription and to provide certain options to the client regarding the filling of such prescription; providing requirements therefor; providing exceptions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

## Section 1. Section 474.224, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 474.224 Veterinary prescription disclosure.-
- (1) (a) Before dispensing a prescription medication, a licensed veterinarian must clearly inform a client of the client's right to receive a written prescription for the medication.
- (b) The veterinarian, or an authorized member of the veterinary staff, must provide the client with the option to have the prescription filled at the veterinary clinic or to obtain a written prescription that may be filled at a pharmacy of the client's choice.
- (c) Each disclosure required under this subsection shall be made:
