6       **Section 5. Section 205.0532, Florida Statutes, is amended**

8       205.0532 Revocation or refusal to renew; doing business  
9 with Cuba.—

10       (1) Any appropriate tax collector or local governing  
11 authority issuing a business tax receipt to any individual,  
12 business, or entity under this chapter may revoke or refuse to  
13 renew such receipt if the individual, business, or entity, ~~or~~  
14 ~~parent company of such individual, business, or entity,~~ is doing  
15 business with Cuba in violation of federal law.

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16        (2) Any appropriate tax collector or local governing  
17        authority is authorized to request a sworn affidavit or  
18        declaration from any individual, business, or entity attesting  
19        to whether the individual, business, or entity is doing business  
20        with Cuba in violation of federal law.

21        (3) A person who knowingly makes a false declaration under  
22        subsection (2) is guilty of the crime of perjury by false  
23        written declaration, a felony of the third degree, punishable as  
24        provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
