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9       Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:  
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11           **Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section**  
12 **319.30, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

13       319.30 Definitions; dismantling, destruction, change of  
14 identity of motor vehicle, vessel, or mobile home; salvage.—

16       (d) An electronic signature that is consistent with  
17 chapter 668 satisfies any signature required under this  
18 subsection, except that an electronic signature on an odometer  
19 disclosure submitted through an insurance company must be  
20 executed using an electronic signature, as defined in s.  
21 668.003(4). The insurance company or its authorized agent shall  
22 implement control processes and procedures acceptable to the  
23 department to ensure adequate identity verification,  
24 preservation, disposition, integrity, security, confidentiality,  
25 and auditability of the electronic signature, ~~which uses a~~

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~~system providing an Identity Assurance Level, Authenticator Assurance Level, and Federation Assurance Level, as described in the National Institute of Standards and Technology Special Publication 800-63-3, as of December 1, 2017, which are equivalent to or greater than Level 2, for each level, for a certificate of destruction or for a salvage certificate of title.~~

**Section 2.** This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
