A bill to be entitled
An act relating to electronic payments made to units
of local governments; amending s. 215.322, F.S.;
revising legislative intent; requiring units of local
government to accept certain forms of payments;
requiring such local governments to accept payments
online; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (1) and (5) of section 215.322, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

215.322 Acceptance of credit cards, charge cards, debit cards, or electronic funds transfers by state agencies, units of local government, and the judicial branch; acceptance of online payments by units of local governments.—

(1) (a) It is the intent of the Legislature to encourage state agencies, and the judicial branch, and require units of local government to make their goods, services, and information more convenient to the public through the acceptance of payments by credit cards, charge cards, debit cards, or other means of electronic funds transfers to the maximum extent practicable when the benefits to the participating agency and the public substantiate the cost of accepting these types of payments.

(b) It is the intent of the Legislature to require units

27 (5) (a) Each A unit of local government, including a
28 municipality, special district, or board of county commissioners
29 or other governing body of a county, a consolidated or
30 metropolitan government, and any clerk of the circuit court,

39 other statutorily prescribed revenues an amount sufficient to

42 services. Such A unit of local government shall verify both the
43 validity of any credit card, charge card, bank debit card, or
44 electronic funds transfer used pursuant to this subsection and
45 the existence of appropriate credit with respect to the person
46 using the card or transfer. The unit of local government does
47 not incur any liability as a result of such verification or any
48 subsequent action taken.

49 (b) A unit of local government accepting payment under
50 paragraph (a) is required to have a method for accepting such
