The Conference Committee Amendment for SB 2508-E, relating to the State Agency Law Enforcement Radio System (SLERS), conforms statutes to funding decisions related to SLERS in the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for Fiscal Year 2026-2027. The proposed amendment removes the scheduled expiration date of July 1, 2026, from the \$3 surcharge imposed on all noncriminal moving traffic violations and specified criminal offenses. The surcharge generates approximately \$4 million annually for the State Agency Law Enforcement Radio System Trust Fund to support the operation and maintenance of the Statewide Law Enforcement Radio System.
