Statewide Drug Control; creates Office of Drug Control within Executive Office of Governor; provides for office to be headed by director appointed by Governor & subject to Senate confirmation; requires director of said office to report annually to Governor & Legislature; creates Statewide Drug Policy Advisory Council within Executive Office of Governor; provides for payment of per diem & travel expenses; amends provisions to conform, etc. Amends Ch. 397. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### CS/CS/SB 94 by the Committees on Fiscal Policy, Criminal Justice and Senator Rossin

**Driving or Boating Under Influence**; increases penalty imposed for fourth or subsequent conviction of DUI; increases penalties imposed for causing serious bodily injury while driving under influence; provides that it is first-degree felony to cause death of another while DUI; revises blood-alcohol or breath-alcohol level; provides that previous convictions for boating under influence are to be considered for purposes of penalties, etc. Amends 316.193, 327.35, 921.0022. Effective Date: 10/01/1999.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### SB 168 by Senator McKay

**Alcohol or Drugs/DUI;** provides that motor vehicle is subject to forfeiture under Fla. Contraband Act if motor vehicle is driven by person under influence of alcohol or drugs & person's license is suspended as result of prior conviction for DUI; requires that notification of impoundment or seizure be sent to HSMV Dept.; redefines term "contraband article" re Fla. Contraband Act to conform to changes made by act, etc. Amends 322.34, 932.701; reenacts 932.703. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Criminal Justice and reported favorably, with two amendments, by the Committee on Transportation and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### CS/SB 156 by the Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs, Senator Hargrett and others

**Alcohol & Tobacco Products/Minors**; amends provision re purchase of alcohol by minors; provides restrictions on locations for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages; amends provision re purchase of tobacco products by minors. Amends 562.11,.45, 569.11. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Regulated Industries and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs

### CS/SB 60 by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Brown-Waite and others

**Pretrial Intervention Programs**; authorizes court to deny admission of defendant to pretrial substance-abuse education & treatment intervention program if defendant has rejected any prior offer of admission to such program. Amends 948.08. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice and the Committee on Fiscal Resource reports the Committee substitute favorably

### SB 138 by Senator Bronson

Victims & Witnesses/Fair Treatment; allows specified state agencies to participate in crime prevention & educational activities re fair treatment of victims & witnesses in justice system; provides for use of funds appropriated for prevention activities. Amends 960.001. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Productivity, and withdrawn from the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### CS/SB 166 by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Brown-Waite and others

Law Enforcement Agencies/Operations; provides it is third-degree felony to contact or communicate with any person who is directly involved in tactical operation of law enforcement agency or to authorize broadcast or telecast of any recording or depiction of tactical operation of law enforcement agency during course of operation; requires that law enforcement agency inform public of conclusion of such tactical operation; encourages development of protocol, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice and withdrawn from the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### SB 72 by Senator Campbell

Homicide/Vehicular & Vessel; increases penalties imposed for committing offense of vehicular homicide or vessel homicide; increases penalties imposed for committing vehicular homicide or vessel homicide & failing to give information & render aid when offender knew, or should have known, that accident occurred; amends certain provision re Criminal Punishment Code; conforms references to changes made by act. Amends 782.071,.072, 921.0022. Effective Date: 10/01/1999.

Reported favorably by the Committees on Criminal Justice and Fiscal Policy

### CS/SB 152 by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Brown-Waite and others

Controlled Substances; amends provision re scheduling of controlled substances for purpose of penalizing unlawful acts involving controlled substances; deletes references to dextropropoxyphene in its nondosage forms from Schedule II; adds references to propoxyphene in its nondosage forms to Schedule II; deletes references to gamma-hydroxy-butyrate from Schedule II; adds references to gamma-hydroxybutyric acid to Schedule II, etc. Amends Ch. 893; reenacts FS. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice

### SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

### CS/CS/SB 2 by the Committees on Children and Families, Judiciary, Senator Campbell and others

**Adoption;** removes provisions authorizing licensed child-placing agencies to file actions to terminate parental rights; provides additional requirements for petition for adoption; prohibits filing such petition until order terminating parental rights is final; provides duties of adoption entity to prospective adoptive parents; provides for placement of minor pending adoption, etc. Amends Chs. 39, 63, 984.03, 985.03. Effective Date: 10/01/1999.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Children and Families

#### CS/SB 62 by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, Senator Thomas and others

**Bone Marrow Transplants**; requires that coverage for bone-marrow-transplant procedures include costs of donor patient; makes legislative finding that provisions of act fulfill important state interest. Amends 627.4236. Effective Date: 01/01/2000.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, and withdrawn from the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### CS/SB 64 by the Committee on Judiciary, Senator Grant and others

Citizen Participation in Govt. Act; creates "Citizen Participation in Government Act" & provides for its purposes; defines terms; provides procedures for judiciary to respond to lawsuits re constitutional right to petition government for redress of grievances. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary and the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Productivity, reports the Committee substitute favorably, with one amendment

### SB 86 by Senator Campbell and others

Game Promotions; redefines terms "game promotion" & "operator" & defines term "older individual"; prohibits certain acts in connection with game promotions & promotional materials therefor; requires certain information to be printed on envelopes; revises provision re maintenance & distribution of winner lists; provides penalties, including increased penalties when unlawful

act is against older individual. Amends 849.094. Effective Date: 10/01/1999.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Agriculture and Consumer Services

#### SB 92 by Senator Lee

**Campaign Financing**; modifies definitions of terms "political committee," "contribution," & "expenditure"; prohibits committees of continuous existence from making certain expenditures. Amends 106.011,.04. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Ethics and Elections

### CS/SB 108 by the Committee on Commerce and Economic Opportunities and Senator McKay

**Unemployment Compensation;** extends for an additional year temporary reduction in certain contribution rates for specified employers; clarifies provisions re disqualification for benefits; extends for specified period temporary increase in maximum weekly & yearly benefit amounts for unemployment compensation benefits; specifies benefit years; provides extension for Fla. Training Investment Program. Amends 443.101,.111,.231. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Commerce and Economic Opportunities, and the Committee on Fiscal Resource reports the Committee substitute favorably

#### SB 112 by Senator Kurth and others

**Skateboarding & Inline Skating**; provides limitations on liability re governmental entities & public employees re persons who participate in skateboarding, inline skating, or freestyle bicycle riding activities on property owned or leased by governmental entity; provides for liability of independent concessionaires or other persons or organizations for certain injuries or damages; provides for effect of certain insurance, etc. Creates 316.0085. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs, and reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Productivity, and withdrawn from the Committee on Fiscal Policy

#### SB 114 by Senator Brown-Waite

Florida Independent Living Council; authorizes Florida Independent Living Council to incorporate as corporation not for profit; allows increase in number of members; amends prerequisites to Governor's appointment of council members. Amends 413.395. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Commerce and Economic Opportunities

### SB 130 by Senator Klein

**Juveniles/Prosecution as Adults;** provides for juvenile to be prosecuted as adult if juvenile is charged with grand theft of motor vehicle; reenacts certain provision re state attorney's authority to prosecute juvenile as adult, to incorporate amendment in reference thereto. Amends 985.227; reenacts 985.21(4)(e). Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Criminal Justice and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

#### SB 132 by Senator Klein and others

Sales Tax/Coins, Currency, Bullion; exempts from tax on sale of coins or currency certain transactions in which sales price exceeds specified amount; exempts sales of gold, silver, or platinum bullion when sales price exceeds specified amount. Amends 212.05,.08. Effective Date: 07/01/1999 except as otherwise expressly provided.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Fiscal Resource and reported favorably by the Committee on Commerce and Economic Opportunities

#### SB 134 by Senator Klein

Controlled Substances/Child Care; corrects misplaced statutory provision re unlawful sale or possession of controlled substance within specified area surrounding child care facility; provides that certain enhanced penalties do not apply unless owner or operator of facility posts sign identifying facility as child care facility. Amends 893.13. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal Justice and withdrawn from the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### CS/SB 140 by the Committee on Fiscal Resource, Senator Cowin and others

Health Maintenance Contracts; revises procedures & standards for rate changes made by organization; deletes current provisions that allow rate changes to be implemented immediately upon filing with Insurance Dept., subject to disapproval; requires rate changes to be filed with department specified time period prior to use; provides that filing is deemed approved after certain time period absent affirmative approval or disapproval by department; makes conforming changes. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance

### CS/SB 1264 by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Rossin

Consumer Finance; increases application fee; requires licensees to notify Banking & Finance Dept. before relocating business; requires licensee to report bankruptcy filings to dept.; deletes schedule of examination fees; requires disclosure of additional information & evidence of satisfaction of lien under certain installment contracts; authorizes rules to allow electronic submission of forms, documents, & fees, etc. Amends Chs. 516, 520, 559, 615, 681, 697. Effective Date: 10/01/1999 except as otherwise provided.

#### SB 1268 by Senator Myers

**Regional Planning/Energy**; enumerates energy planning as specific component that may be addressed in strategic regional

policy plan. Amends 186.507. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs

#### SB 1276 by Senator Gutman

**Voter Registration**; eliminates information & notice requirements re homestead exemption from uniform statewide voter registration application; eliminates requirement that supervisor of elections must forward to property appraiser names & homestead addresses of persons registering to vote at address other than that at which they claim homestead exemption; eliminates requirement that property appraiser examine such forwarded information, etc. Amends Chs. 97, 98, 196. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

### CS/SB 1280 by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Laurent

#### CS/SB 1282 by the Committee on Judiciary and Senator Laurent

Clerks of Circuit Court; provides that Official Records are general series of records; provides that register of said records be made available at branch offices; extends time within which to pay witness or juror; requires successful bidder at tax deed sale to pay specified deposit; provides eligibility for extra compensation to employees of clerk of circuit court; provides that citation for possession of tobacco by minor must be paid within specified time, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

### SB 1396 by Senator Burt

**Drugs, Devices, Cosmetics/FDA**; exempts from certain provisions each manufacturer of medical devices that are approved by, registered with, & listed with federal FDA; requires certain information to be submitted with such manufacturer's application for permit to do business in this state. Amends 499.015. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Health, Aging and Long-Term Care

### SB 1464 by Senator Dyer

**Depopulation/JUA**; repeals provision re Fla. Residential Property & Casualty Joint Underwriting Association re qualification of insurer for exemption from certain assessment; provides retroactive application. Repeals 627.3511(5)(b). Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Banking and Insurance

### CS/SB 1494 by the Committee on Regulated Industries and Senator Saunders

Water & Wastewater Systems; redefines term "governmental authority"; provides for additional exemption; authorizes specified transactions before Public Service Commission approval.

Amends 367.021,.022,.071. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Regulated Industries

### SB 1514 by Senator Clary

**Hospices**; prescribes additional subjects that must be addressed in rules of Elderly Affairs Dept.; authorizes physician services to be provided through contract; prescribes additional facilities in which hospice services may be provided; prescribes responsibility for care & services of persons admitted to hospice programs. Amends 400.605, 609. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Health, Aging and Long-Term Care


