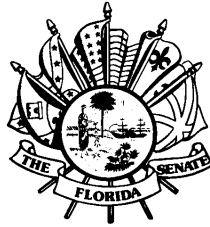

## BILLS ON CALENDAR

### BILLS ON THIRD READING

#### **CS/CS/SB's 366, 382 & SB 708 by the Committee on Fiscal Policy, the Committee on Education, Holzendorf, Kirkpatrick and others**

**School Readiness Program;** (THIS BILL COMBINES CS/S366,382,S708) establishes Fla. Partnership for School Readiness for purposes of administering School Readiness Program; requires that partnership prepare system for measuring school readiness; requires establishment of school readiness coalitions; creates School Readiness Program Estimating Conference; requires Healthy Kids Corp. to work cooperatively with said partnership, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise expressly provided.

*Read the second time and amended on March 2, 1999*

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#### **SB 380 by Senator Webster**

**Firefighters & Police Pension TF;** amends & revises provisions re Municipal Firefighters' Pension Trust Funds & Municipal Police Officers' Retirement Trust Funds; provides that certain benefits provided are minimum & may not be diminished by any other state, local, or federal benefits; provides exception; modifies formula for calculating volunteer firefighter service retirement benefits; provides for optional participation, etc. Amends Chs. 175, 185. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

### SPECIAL ORDER CALENDAR AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES AND CALENDAR FOR THURSDAY, MARCH 4, 1999

#### **CS/SB 314 by the Committee on Ethics and Elections, Senator Latvala and others**

**Campaign Finance Reform Act;** modifies definitions of terms "political committee," "contribution," "expenditure," & "political advertisement"; provides additional requirements for registration of political committees & committees of continuous existence; prohibits committees of continuous existence from making certain expenditures; revises contribution limit for statewide candidates; limits amount of contributions to political party, etc. Amends & reenacts Ch. 106. Effective Date: 01/01/2000.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Ethics and Elections*

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#### **CS/SB 194 by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Webster and others**

**Felons/Increased Prison Terms;** amends provisions re felony reclassification & minimum sentence & other penalties for offenders who committed aggravated battery or committed certain acts involving weapon, firearm, or destructive device during commission of felony; provides that minimum term of imprisonment imposed is authorized by law regardless of maximum sentence that may be imposed for underlying felony, etc. Amends 775.087; reenacts 921.0022(2),.0024(1)(b), 947.146(3). Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice and the Committee on Fiscal Policy reports the Committee substitute favorably*

## **SB 34 by Senator Dyer**

**Relief/Cruz/West Volusia Hospital;** provides for relief of Jose Alberto Cruz, Jr., a minor, & his parents & natural guardians, Nelida Cruz & Jose Alberto Cruz, Sr., for injuries & damages caused by hospital's negligence. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Health, Aging and Long-Term Care, and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 6 by Senator Forman**

**Relief/Marquez/Metro-Dade Police;** provides for relief of Ana Quintana-Marquez & Juan Marquez, her husband, for injuries & damages sustained as result of collision with Metro-Dade police car. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably by the Committees on Rules and Calendar, and Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 22 by Senator Silver**

**Relief/Joseph/Dade Metro Police;** requires Dade County to compensate children of Elionne Joseph for her death as result of negligence of Dade Metro Police. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs, and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 46 by Senator Jones**

**Relief/Sosa/Metropolitan Dade Co.;** provides for relief of Martha Sosa; compensates her for injuries & damages sustained as result of negligence of Metropolitan Dade County. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Transportation and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 14 by Senator Holzendorf**

**Relief/Trey Anthony Alls/DOT;** provides for relief of Trey Anthony Alls for injuries sustained as result of Transportation Department negligence. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Transportation and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 20 by Senator Grant**

**Relief/Patricia D. Baker/DOT;** provides for relief of Patricia D. Baker; compensates her for injuries & damages sustained as

result of negligence of Florida Transportation Department. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Transportation and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 24 by Senator Campbell**

**Relief/Brown/Delray Beach;** provides for relief of estate of Charlie Brown, Jr. for damages sustained as result of city's negligence in misplacing evidence re accident that critically injured him. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably by the Committees on Rules and Calendar, and Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 26 by Senator Rossin**

**Relief/Robert Rosado/Palm Beach Co.;** provides for relief of Robert Rosado for injuries sustained due to negligence of Palm Beach County. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs, and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 32 by Senator Myers**

**Relief/Eubanks & Black;** (Palm Beach Co.) provides for relief of Jennifer Eubanks-Black, David Black, John Eubanks, & Ivy Dawn Eubanks; compensates them for injuries & damages sustained due to negligence of Palm Beach County. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably by the Committees on Rules and Calendar, and Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 48 by Senator Sullivan**

**Relief/Gilfoyle/Clearwater;** provides for relief of Paul W. Gilfoyle, through his guardian Anne-Marie Cherokee Lindsey, for damages sustained in collision with police car driven by City of Clearwater patrolman. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules and Calendar, and reported favorably, with two amendments, by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

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## **SB 40 by Senator Campbell and others**

**Relief/Weathington/Tallahassee;** provides for relief of Warren Weathington & his father, Carl Weathington, for injuries sustained as result of negligent conduct of tennis pros employed by City of Tallahassee. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs, and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

## SB 4 by Senator Forman

**Relief/Joseph B. Farver/CFS Dept.;** compensates Joseph Bellamy Farver for injuries & damages sustained as result of negligence of Children & Family Services Dept., formerly Health & Rehabilitative Services Department. Effective Date: 07/01/1999.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Children and Families, and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

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## SB 8 by Senator Jones

**Relief/Jose & Johannes Pena/Hialeah;** provides for relief of Jose Pena, as Personal Representative of Estate of Carmen Pena, deceased, & individually, as surviving father of Katherine Pena & Richard Pena, minor children of Carmen Pena & Jose Pena, deceased; provides for relief of Johannes Pena, surviving son of Carmen Pena; compensates them for death of Carmen Pena, Katherine Pena, & Richard Pena as result of negligence of City of Hialeah. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Recommended favorably, with one amendment, by The Special Master on Claim Bills and reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs, and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Resource*

## SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

### CS/CS/SB 2 by the Committees on Children and Families, Judiciary, Senator Campbell and others

**Adoption;** removes provisions authorizing licensed child-placing agencies to file actions to terminate parental rights; provides additional requirements for petition for adoption; prohibits filing such petition until order terminating parental rights is final; provides duties of adoption entity to prospective adoptive parents; provides for placement of minor pending adoption, etc. Amends Chs. 39, 63, 984.03, 985.03. Effective Date: 10/01/1999.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Children and Families*

### CS/SB 60 by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Brown-Waite and others

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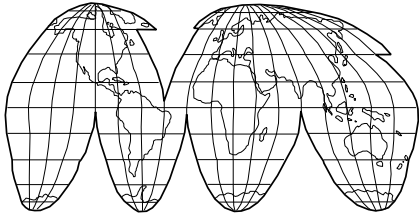

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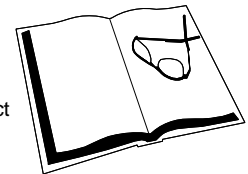
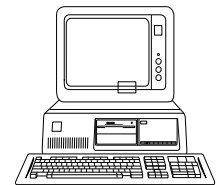
