SB 1334 by Senator Lee

Official Florida Statutes Adoption; adopts Florida Statutes 2002 & designates portions thereof that are to constitute official law of state; provides that Florida Statutes 2002 shall be effective immediately upon publication; provides that general laws enacted during 2001 regular session & prior thereto & not included in Florida Statutes 2002 are repealed, etc. Amends 11.2421,.2422,.2424,.2425. Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.

SB 1336 by Senator Lee

Florida Statutes; deletes provisions which have expired, have become obsolete, have had their effect, have served their purpose, or have been impliedly repealed or superseded; replaces incorrect cross-references & citations; corrects grammatical, typographical, & like errors; removes inconsistencies, redundancies, & unnecessary repetition in statutes, etc. Amends/Reenacts/Repeals various FS. Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.

SB 1338 by Senator Lee

Florida Statutes; repeals provisions pursuant to specified provisions all of which provisions have become inoperative by noncurrent repeal or expiration & , pursuant to specified provision, may be omitted from Florida Statutes 2002 only through reviser's bill duly enacted by Legislature, etc. Repeals various FS; amends 550.6305(9)(a). Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.
