**Driver's License Requirements/Trucks;** applies bumper height restrictions to vehicles weighing up to 10,000 pounds; provides exception to driver's license requirements or operators of certain trucks & tractor trailers. Amends 316.251, 322.54. Effective Date: 07/01/2003.

Amends 367.081,.0814. Effective Date: Upon becoming law


