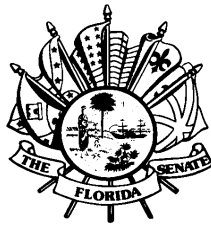

#### **REVISER'S BILLS**

##### **SB 580 (SO) by Senator Lee—**

**Florida Statutes;** amends, transfers & renumbers specified provisions; reenacts & repeals specified provisions pursuant to specific provision; deletes provisions that have expired, have become obsolete, have had their effect, have served their purpose, or have been impliedly repealed or superseded; replaces incorrect cross-references & citations; corrects grammatical, typographical, & like errors, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.

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##### **SB 582 (SO) by Senator Lee—**

**Florida Statutes;** repeals provisions which have become inoperative by noncurrent repeal or expiration & , pursuant to certain provisions, may be omitted from Florida Statutes 2003 only through reviser's bill duly enacted by Legislature; amends provisions to conform to repeal of specific provision; reenacts specific provision to conform to reenactment & amendment of paragraph (b) of that subsection by s. 10, ch. 2002-218, Laws of Florida. Amends FS. Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.

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##### **SB 584 (SO) by Senator Lee—**

**Florida Statutes;** amends provisions to conform to directive in s. 1, ch. 93-199, Laws of Florida, to remove gender-specific references applicable to human beings from Florida Statutes without substantive change in legal effect. Amends 411.226, 1011.31,.42, 1013.12. Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.

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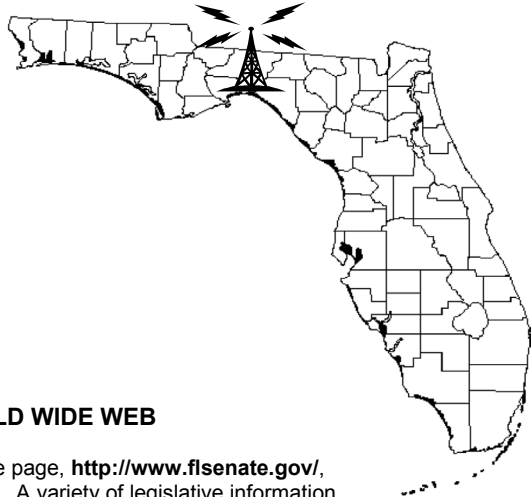
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
