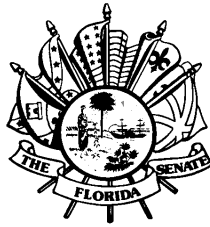

Hospitals/Off-premises Emergency Department; authorizes hospitals to operate off-premises emergency department; requires license; provides criteria; provides that all said departments operating as of certain date may continue to operate in accordance with criteria in effect at time of approval & that said department that has had architectural plans approved by certain date is subject to license criteria in effect at time of submission. 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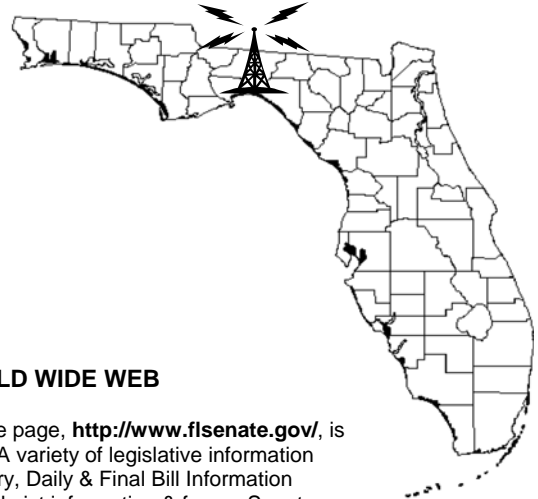
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
