Effective Date: 01/01/2008.

CS/SB 1644 (3R) by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations, Senator Gaetz and others—

Theft; provides enhanced penalties for theft exceeding specified amount for persons who individually, or in concert with others, coordinate activities of one or more persons in committing theft; provides enhanced penalties for retail theft exceeding specified amount for persons who individually, or in concert with others, coordinate activities of one or more persons in committing offense, etc. Amends 812.014,.015, 921.0022. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

CS/SB 1676 (3R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice and Senator Oelrich—

Off-road Vehicles/Law Enforcement; authorizes law enforcement agencies to use specific off-road vehicles on streets, roads, & highways of this state; provides requirements for such vehicles. Creates 316.21265. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Identical to **CS/HB 1003 (HC)** in the Committees on Transportation and Criminal Justice

CS/CS/SB 500 (3R) by the Committees on General Government Appropriations, Regulated Industries and Senator Saunders—

Instant Bingo; cites act as "Evelyn Wiesman-Price Act"; defines terms "deal", "flare" & "instant bingo"; exempts instant bingo from specified prohibitions; provides requirements for operation of instant bingo games & use of proceeds & prize payout; provides requirements for manufacture & sale of instant bingo tickets; provides penalties, etc. Amends 849.0931; reenacts 718.114, 723.079(8). Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time on April 20, 2007

CS/SB 744 (3R) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Alexander—

Automated Teller Machine Transactions; prohibits slot machine licensee from allowing automatic teller machines to be located in certain areas of pari-mutuel facility; authorizes machine owners or operators to impose access fees or surcharges for machine use; provides certain agreement prohibitions re machine access fees or surcharges; provides for construction re certain fee-free or surcharge-free network agreements, etc. Amends 551.121, 655.966. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

SB 672 (3R) by Senator Fasano—

CS/SB's 2730, SB 1596 (3R) by the Committee on Regulated Industries, Senators Joyner and Constantine—


