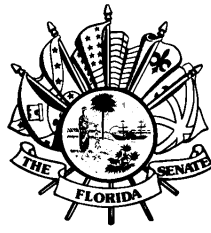

### MATTERS ON RECONSIDERATION

#### ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [EPCC] GROUPING

**CS/HB 97 (MR) by the Healthcare Council and Representative Hays—**

**Medicare Supplement Policies;** revises definition of term "Medicare supplement policy" to exclude health insurance policy or other health benefit plan offered by one or more employers to employees or former employees; provides limitation. Amends 627.672. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for CS/CS/SB 266 (SUB) (Baker) and read the second time, third time and passed on April 25, 2007; and motion to reconsider pending by Senator Siplin (April 25, 2007)*

### BILLS ON THIRD READING

#### ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [EPCC] GROUPING

**CS/SB's 2730, SB 1596 (3R) by the Committee on Regulated Industries, Senators Joyner and Constantine—**

**Residential Tenancies;** (THIS BILL COMBINES S2730 & S1596) allows landlord to terminate rental agreement & recover liquidated damages or charge tenant early termination fee for breach of agreement, or both, under certain circumstances; requires tenant to indicate acceptance of early termination fee or liquidated-damages provision in rental agreement in order for provision to take effect; provides limit on combined total of damages & fee, etc. Amends 83.43,.595. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Read the second time on April 20, 2007*

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### CS/SB 1900 (3R) by the Committee on Transportation and Senator Baker—

**Specialty License Plates;** discontinues annual use fee for Girl Scout license plate; increases annual use fee for Sea Turtle & Fla. Sheriffs Youth Ranches license plate; establishes annual use fees for Fla. NASCAR, Corrections Foundation, Protect Fla. Springs, & Trees Are Cool license plates; authorizes use of specified percentage of proceeds from sale of Fla. Educational license plate for marketing & promotion expenses, etc. Amends Ch. 320. Effective Date: 10/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

*Read the second time and amended on April 20, 2007*

### LAW AND JUSTICE POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [LPCC] GROUPING

**CS/CS/SB 1792 (3R) by the Committees on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations, Transportation, the Committee on Criminal Justice (Argenziano) and others—**

**Department of Corrections;** includes vehicles operated by DOC within term "authorized emergency vehicles" for purposes of Fla. Uniform Traffic Control Law; authorizes department to operate vehicles that have emergency lights & sirens; provides for funds in Employee Benefit Trust Fund to be used for certain additional purposes; authorizes court to issue notice to appear for certain violators, etc. Amends Ch. 316, 945.215,.21501, 948.06. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/SB 988 (3R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice and Senator Argenziano—**

**High-risk Offenders;** requires distinctive markings for driver's licenses & ID cards issued to persons who are designated as sexual predators or subject to registration as sexual offenders; requires said predators & offenders to obtain updated or renewed driver's license or ID card; revises background screening requirements for certain noninstructional school district employees & contractors; provides for submission of fingerprints, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/SB 2312 (3R) by the Committee on Judiciary, Senator Oelrich and others—**

**Florida False Claims Act;** provides that purpose of said act is to prevent state from paying false & fraudulent claims; redefines term "claim" to include claims filed electronically; provides that person is liable for civil penalty if he or she files false or fraudulent claim; reduces time limits for false claim proceedings; revises period in which stay to conduct discovery may be granted, etc. Amends 68.081-.085,.089. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/HB 449 (3R) by the Safety & Security Council, Representative Snyder and others—**

**Criminal Offenses/State of Emergency;** provides enhanced penalties for burglaries of authorized emergency vehicles; provides enhanced penalties for specified burglaries that are committed during state of emergency declared by Governor & facilitated by conditions arising from emergency; provides enhanced penalties for theft of certain property stolen during state of emergency declared by Governor & facilitated by conditions arising from emergency, etc. Amends 810.02, 812.014, 921.0022. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for CS/SB 214 (SUB) (Aronberg) and read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/SB 1342 (3R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice, the Committee on Criminal Justice (Argenziano) and others—**

**False Personation/Law Enforcement Officer;** amends provision re unlawfully showing or displaying certain lights to provide that unlawful display of blue lights is first-degree misdemeanor; prohibits impersonation of federal law enforcement officer; provides that unlawful use of flashing or rotating blue lights is third-degree felony rather than misdemeanor; amends provision re unlawful use of police badges or other indicia of authority, etc. Amends Ch. 843, 316.2397, 921.0022. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/HB 339 (3R) by the Safety & Security Council, Representative Scionti and others—**

**Federal Law Enforcement Officers;** redefines term "law enforcement officer" to include federal law enforcement officer for purposes of certain enhanced penalties imposed for offense of assault or battery of law enforcement officer; reenacts provisions re screening standards, arrest without warrant, offense severity ranking chart, & fingerprinting of minors, to incorporate amendments to specified provisions in references thereto. Amends 784.07, 843.08; reenacts FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for SB 614 (SUB) (Crist) and read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/SB 1460 (3R) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, Senator Joyner and others—**

**Judicial & Execution Sales/Property;** requires that, before certain court-ordered sales of property, lienholder serve notice on property owner of possibility of relief through filing of bankruptcy petition; amends provision re required service of notice of potential relief through bankruptcy; clarifies that number of days for publishing notice re foreclosure proceeding excludes legal holidays, etc. Creates 702.55; amends 56.021, 702.035. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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**SB 1448 (3R) by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security (Dockery)—**

**Service Members/Dependent Assistance;** provides that eligibility for Family Readiness Program continues for specified period following termination of service member's orders & his or her return home; revises provisions requiring that inspector general conduct reviews & audits of program. Amends 250.5206. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/SB 2196 (3R) by the Committee on Judiciary and Senator Villalobos—**

**Truth in Government Act;** provides short title; eliminates authority for members of legislative committee to administer certain oaths & affirmations to witnesses; requires persons who address legislative committee to take oath or affirmation of truthfulness; provides exceptions; requires member of said committee to administer oath or affirmation; provides criminal penalties for certain false statements before said committee, etc. Amends 11.143; creates 11.1435. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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**HB 143 (3R) by Representative Dean and others—**

**Criminal Justice Commission**; requires Criminal Justice Standards & Training Commission to adopt rules for implementation of federal Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2004; requires commission to develop & authorize issuance of uniform firearms proficiency verification card; authorizes use of specified facilities operating firing ranges for testing of persons other than law enforcement officers. Creates 943.132. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **SB 1774 (SUB)** (Crist) and read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/CS/SB 1630 (3R) by the Committees on Governmental Operations, Military Affairs and Domestic Security, Senator Dockery and others—**

**U.S. Marine Corps License Plate/Fee**; revises authorized allocation of annual use fee. Amends 320.08058. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/SB 122 (3R) by the Committee on Judiciary and Senator Posey—**

**Child Custody/Not Modifying Child Custody**; prohibits court from modifying child custody during time parent is activated, deployed, or temporarily assigned to military service; provides limited exception; requires reinstatement upon parent's return from military service; limits application of prohibition. Creates 61.13002. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**SB 978 (3R) by Senator Aronberg—**

**Court-ordered Nonbinding Arbitration**; revises provisions re presentation of testimony & evidence in said arbitration proceedings; revises provisions re award of specified costs in trial de novo following arbitration against party requesting trial when trial judgment differs from arbitration award by certain amount. Amends 44.103. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/SB 142 (3R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Wise and others—**

**Change of Name Petition**; requires that person filing petition for change of name submit fingerprints for state & national criminal history records check before court hearing on petition; provides procedures for taking & submission of fingerprints; provides for payment of costs associated with processing fingerprints & conducting criminal history checks; requires return of results of said records check to clerk of court, etc. Amends 68.07. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**HB 723 (3R) by Representative N. Thompson and others—**

**Correctional/Law Enforcement Officer**; requires that certain investigative reports include statement re compliance with specified provisions, & that these reports be verified; requires that certain statements be made under oath & subject to prosecution for perjury. Amends 112.533. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Substituted for **SB 690 (SUB)** (Haridopolos) and read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/CS/SB 2038 (3R) by the Committees on Governmental Operations, Judiciary and Senator King—**

**Real Property Electronic Recording**; creates "Uniform Real Property Electronic Recording Act"; provides for validity of electronic documents re real property; provides for recording of electronic documents by county recorder; creates Electronic Recording Advisory Committee; provides that such electronic documents are subject to same taxes as paper documents; provides for electronic filing of certain required returns, etc. Creates 695.27, amends 201.01,.022. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/CS/SB 448 (3R) by the Committees on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations, Judiciary, Senator Fasano and others—**

**County Funding/Court Personnel**; specifies that county be considered employer; provides that employees funded by county under this section & other county employees may be aggregated for purposes of flexible benefits plan; prescribes supervisory duties of judicial circuit; revises status of positions funded under section. Amends 29.0081. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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**CS/HB 311 (3R) by the Safety & Security Council, Representative Hukill and others—**

**Probate**; specifies additional circumstances under which certain funds or accounts are not exempt from surviving spouse's claims; provides prerequisite to admitting will to probate or appointing personal representative under certain circumstances; provides for enforceability of will or trust provisions requiring arbitration of certain disputes; revises provisions re elective estate & elective share, etc. Amends Chs. 731, 732, 733, 734, 222.21, 895.02. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 1936 (SUB)** (Joyner) and read the second time on April 25, 2007*

## **RESPONSIBLE REGULATION POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [RPCC] GROUPING**

### **CS/CS/CS/SB 2054 (3R) by the Committees on General Government Appropriations, Communications and Public Utilities, Environmental Preservation and Conservation and the Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation (Saunders)—**

**Environmental Protection;** creates penalties for violation of rules adopted under State Parks & Preserves chapter & for specified activities within boundaries of state park; provides statewide consistency for water quality standards in NFWFMD; ratifies wetland rule & amends it to include certain plant species approved by Environmental Reg. Comm.; provides for revision of water pollution operation permits, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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### **CS/CS/SB 1974 (3R) by the Committees on General Government Appropriations, Governmental Operations, the Committee on Governmental Operations (Lawson) and others—**

**State Information Technology;** creates Agency for Enterprise Information Technology within Governor's Executive Office; amends provisions re Financial Mgt. Info. Board, & its coordination council, State Technology Office, SUNCOM network, transportation planning, Health Info. Systems Council, expedited permitting, Fla. Center for Health Info. & Policy Analysis, state housing strategy & Fla. Housing Finance Corp., Criminal & Juvenile Justice Info. System Council, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 25, 2007*

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### **CS/SB 2766 (3R) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Posey—**

**Venomous Reptiles & Reptiles of Concern;** requires FWC to establish list of reptiles of concern subject to regulation; prohibits unlawful capturing, keeping, possessing, transporting, or exhibiting of venomous reptiles or reptiles of concern; authorizes commission to inspect said reptiles held in captivity; authorizes commission to revoke licenses & permits under certain circumstances; requires commission to adopt rules for transportation of said reptiles, etc. Amends Ch. 372. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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## **CS/CS/SB 1818 (3R) by the Committees on Governmental Operations, Communications and Public Utilities and Senator Haridopolos—**

**Telecommunications Industry/Reports;** revises due date of report to Legislature by PSC on industry competition; provides for commission to request data from providers of local exchange telecommunications services; requires such providers to file certain information with commission. Amends 364.386. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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### **SB 1510 (3R) by Senator Aronberg—**

**Pub. Rec./Sunshine State One-Call;** creates exemption from public-records requirements for proprietary confidential business information held by Sunshine State One-Call of Fla., Inc.; defines term "proprietary confidential business information"; provides for future legislative repeal & review under OGSR Act; provides findings of public necessity. Creates 556.113. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 25, 2007*

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### **CS/SB 1764 (3R) by the Committee on Community Affairs, Senator Saunders and others—**

**Tax Increment Financing/Conservation Lands;** authorizes two or more counties, or combination of at least one county & municipality, to establish tax increment area for conservation lands by interlocal agreement; requires establishment of separate reserve account for each tax increment area; provides that WMD may be party to said agreement; requires certain approvals from DEP & DCA; provides that revenue bonds may be paid only from revenues deposited into separate reserve account, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

**SB 2230 (2R) by Senator Wise—**

**Accessible Parking Spaces;** provides for reservation of accessible parking spaces for persons who require extra space to exit from or enter motor vehicle; requires signage; requires specific markings; provides penalty. Amends 553.5041. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

**CS/CS/SB 2836 (2R) by the Committees on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations, Community Affairs and Senator Constantine—**

**Florida Building Commission;** requires commission to review requirements in National Electrical Code which relate to bonding & grounding systems for swimming pools; requires commission to make certain determinations before eliminating gravel & stone roofing systems; requires DCA to administer education & outreach program; deletes requirement that certified firesafety inspector be resident of Florida; revises continuing education requirements, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**CS/SB 162 (2R) by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12, Senator Geller and others—**

**Schools/Human Sexuality;** requires school districts to communicate with parents & others concerning school curriculum re teaching of human sexuality to secondary school students; requires that information describe available procedures that parents may use to review curriculum & methods by which parents may provide comments & offer input to school district. Amends 1003.42. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

**CS/CS/SB 188 (2R) by the Committees on Judiciary, Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, Senator Aronberg and others—**

**Domestic Violence/Employee Leave;** defines terms "domestic violence," "employee," "employer," "family or household member," & "victim"; requires that certain employers permit employee to take leave from work to undertake activities resulting from act of domestic violence; requires private employer to keep info. re employee's leave confidential; requires governmental agency to keep such info. confidential & exempt to extent authorized by statute, etc. Creates 741.313. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, and the Committee on Commerce reports the committee substitute favorably and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary and the Committee on General Government Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/CS/SB 224 (2R) by the Committees on Health and Human Services Appropriations, Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, Senator Lynn and others—**

**Suicide Prevention;** creates Statewide Office for Suicide Prevention as unit of Drug Control Office in Executive Office of Governor; authorizes said office to seek & accept grants or funds from any source to support its operation; creates Suicide Prevention Coordinating Council within said office; authorizes coordinating council to assemble ad hoc committee to advise said council, etc. Creates 14.2019,.20195. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, and the Committee on Governmental Operations reports the committee substitute favorably and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations*

*Similar to **CS/HB 139 (HC)** in the Committees on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, Governmental Operations, and Health and Human Services Appropriations*

**CS/SB 644 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Operations and Senator Lynn—**

**State Universities/Buildings/Naming;** provides for naming of facilities of state university for living person by university in accordance with rules of Board of Governors of State University System; authorizes university board of trustees to name building in accordance with specified provision. Amends 267.062, 1013.79. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Higher Education and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Operations and withdrawn from the Committee on Education Facilities Appropriations*

**CS/CS/SB 770 (2R) by the Committees on Governmental Operations, Health Regulation, Senator Atwater and others—**

**Physician Workforce Assessment & Development;** creates Physician Workforce Assessment & Development Office within Health Access & Tobacco Div. of DOH; requires each allopathic & osteopathic physician in state to complete survey re physician's practice as condition of license renewal; specifies information to be furnished to DOH in physician survey; creates Physician Workforce Advisory Council within DOH to assist department re physician workforce issues, etc. Creates 381.4018. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**CS/SB 894 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice and Senator Joyner—**

**Female Genital Mutilation;** defines term "female genital mutilation"; provides that person who commits said mutilation upon female younger than 18 years of age commits felony of first degree; provides that parent or guardian who consents to said mutilation of his or her female child who is younger than 18 years of age commits felony of third degree; provides that consent is not defense to offense of said mutilation, etc. Creates 794.08, amends 921.0022. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

*Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice and withdrawn from the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations*

**CS/SB 1034 (2R) by the Committee on Health Regulation and Senator Atwater—**

**Pub. Rec./Physician Workforce Surveys;** exempts from public-records requirements personal identifying information contained in workforce surveys completed by physicians as condition of license renewal & provided to DOH; authorizes certain entities access to said information; provides guidelines for use of such information; provides for future legislative review & repeal of exemption under OGSRA Act; provides finding of public necessity. Effective Date: Contingent.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health Regulation and the Committee on Governmental Operations reports the committee substitute favorably and withdrawn from the Committee on Rules*

**CS/CS/SB 1602 (2R) by the Committees on Judiciary, Health Regulation, Senator Storms and others—**

**Abortion/Parental Notice;** provides that in hearing re waiving requirement for parental notice, court consider certain additional factors, including whether minor's decision to terminate her pregnancy was due to intimidation or undue influence; provides for severability. Amends 390.01114. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**CS/CS/SB 1916 (2R) by the Committees on Health and Human Services Appropriations, Health Regulation and Senator Fasano—**

**Assisted Living Facilities/Adult Day Care Centers;** requires DOEA to adopt to develop staff training curriculum; requires trainers to be registered with department; requires trainers to document experience & credentials; requires adoption of rules; provides for operation of adult day care centers in temporary locations in event of disaster or emergency; provides notification requirements when adult day care centers relocate. Amends 429.52.,907. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health Regulation and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations*

**CS/SB 2032 (2R) by the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations, Senator Margolis and others—**

**Human Trafficking/Immigrant Survivor;** requires DCFS to provide services to immigrant survivors of human trafficking, domestic violence, & other serious crimes; provides for same state & local benefits that refugees receive; provides survivors of serious crimes with supportive services; provides that sworn statement by victim is sufficient evidence for purposes of determining eligibility for services if supported by at least one piece of additional evidence, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, and withdrawn from the Committee on Community Affairs and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations*

**CS/SB 2102 (2R) by the Committee on Higher Education and Senator Gaetz—**

**Sales Tax/Postsecondary Bookstore;** exempts payments to postsecondary educational institutions made by certain persons granted right to conduct bookstore operations by such institution; provides for retroactive application & for construction of such application. Amends 212.08. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Higher Education and the Committees on Finance and Tax, and General Government Appropriations report the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/CS/SB 2114 (2R) by the Committees on Health and Human Services Appropriations, Judiciary, Senator Rich and others—**

**Independent Living Transition Services;** limits liability of caseworker who signs application for driver's license for minor who is in foster care; revises eligibility criteria for independent living transition services & for Road-to-Independence Program; increases age limit for eligibility for certain persons to qualify for medical assistance payments; provides for removal of disabilities of certain minors for purposes of securing depository financial services, etc. Amends Chs. 322, 409, 743. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

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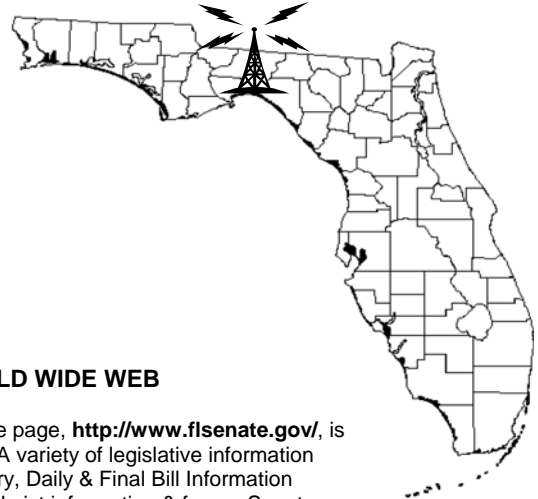
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
