#### CS/SB 136 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Senator Bullard—

**Live the Dream License Plates**; revises use of funds received from sale of plates. Amends 320.08058. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

#### SB 1308 (2R) by Senator Fasano—

**Cooperative Agreement Trust Fund**; redesignates said trust fund within Department of Military Affairs; amends provision re trust funds within department; conforms provisions to changes made by act; terminates specified trust fund within Department of Transportation; provides for disposition of balances in trust fund; prescribes procedures for termination of trust fund. Amends 250.175. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Amends 250.175(2). Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

#### SB 1316 (2R) by Senator Crist—

**Federal Grants Trust Fund/DJJ**; creates said trust fund within Department of Juvenile Justice; provides for sources of funds & purposes; provides for future review & termination or re-creation of trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2008.

Justice Appropriations*

#### SB 1318 (2R) by Senator Peaden—

**Trusts Funds/FDVA/DOH**; terminates specified trust fund within Department of Veterans' Affairs; provides for disposition of balances in & revenues of such trust fund; prescribes procedures for termination of trust fund; amends provision re investments of trust fund moneys to delete obsolete provisions; removes provisions providing for future repeal of Biomedical Research Trust Fund. Amends 17.61, 20.435. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

#### SB 1326 (2R) by Senator Lynn—

**University Concurrency TF/DOE**; re-creates said trust fund within Department of Education without modification; carries forward current balances & continues current sources & uses thereof; abrogates provisions re termination of trust fund, to conform. Repeals 1013.63(4). Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

#### CS/SB 1328 (2R) by the Committee on Higher Education Appropriations and Senator Lynn—

**Trust Funds/State University System**; terminates specified trust funds within Board of Governors of State University System; provides for disposition of balances in & revenues of such trust funds; prescribes procedures for termination of such trust funds; redesignates Trust Fund for University Major Gifts as "University Major Gifts Program"; modifies specified trust funds within Board of Governors of State University System, etc. Amends 1011.94. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

#### CS/SB 1330 (2R) by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations and Senator Wise—

**DOE Trust Funds/Termination**; terminates specified trust funds within Department of Education; provides for disposition of balances in & revenues of such trust funds; prescribes procedures for termination of such trust funds; renames Educational Aids TF within department; repeals provisions re Dale Hickam Excellent Teaching Program TF, Educational Aids TF, & Projects, Contracts, & Grants TF within department, etc. Amends 1002.335; repeals 1010.72,.76,.78, 1012.72(5). Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

**SB 1332 (2R) by Senator Wise—**

**Operating Trust Fund/DOE;** creates said trust fund within Department of Education; provides for sources of funds & purposes; provides for annual carryforward of funds; provides for future review & termination or re-creation of trust fund. Creates 1001.281. Effective Date: 07/01/2008.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations*

**SB 1334 (2R) by Senator Wise—**

**Administrative Trust Fund/DOE;** creates said trust fund within Department of Education; provides for sources of funds & purposes; provides for annual carryforward of funds; provides for future review & termination or re-creation of trust fund. Creates 1001.282. Effective Date: 07/01/2008.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations*

**SB 1428 (2R) by Senator Fasano—**

**Administrative Trust Fund/DOT;** creates said trust fund within Department of Transportation; provides for sources of funds & purposes; provides for future review & termination or re-creation of trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2008.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

**CS/SB 1430 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

**Federal Grants Trust Fund/HSMV;** creates said trust fund within HSMV; provides for sources of funds & purposes; provides for future review & termination or re-creation of trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2008.

**SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY POLICY AND

**CS/SB 246 (2R) by the Committee on Health Regulation,  
Senator Wise and others—**

**Cardiac Catheterization Services;** revises provisions re compliance with certain criteria imposed on any hospital seeking to provide diagnostic cardiac catheterization Level II services. Amends 408.0361. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

**FIRST PUBLICATION ON SECOND READING**

**ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES POLICY AND  
CALENDAR COMMITTEE [EPCC] GROUPING**

**SB 282 (2R) by Senator Fasano—**

**Designated Drivers;** prohibits licensed retail alcohol beverage establishment open to public from denying service to designated driver. Amends 562.51. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Regulated Industries and reported favorably by the Committee on Commerce*

**SB 640 (2R) by Senator Haridopolos—**

**Public Accountancy/Licensure;** removes condition for waiver of certain certified public accountant licensure requirements. Amends 473.308. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Regulated Industries*

**OVERSIGHT AND PROCEDURAL POLICY AND  
CALENDAR COMMITTEE [OPCC] GROUPING**

**SB 2284 (2R) by Senator King—**

**Florida Statutes;** repeals specified provisions all of which have become inoperative by noncurrent repeal or expiration & pursuant to specified provision may be omitted from 2007 Fla. Statutes only through reviser's bill duly enacted by Legislature; amends provisions to conform to repeal of specified provisions. Amends FS. Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 2286 (2R) by Senator King—**

**Official Florida Statutes;** adopts Florida Statutes 2007 & designates portions thereof that are to constitute official law of state; provides that Fla. Statutes 2007 shall be effective immediately upon publication; provides that general laws enacted during 2006 regular session prior thereto & not included in Fla. Statutes 2007 are repealed, etc. Amends 11.2421, .2422, .2424, .2425. Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.

**SB 2288 (2R) by Senator King—**

**Florida Statutes;** amends, reenacts, & repeals various provisions; deletes provisions that have expired, have become obsolete, have had their effect, have served their purpose, or have been impliedly repealed or superseded; replaces incorrect cross-references & citations; corrects grammatical, typographical, & like errors; removes inconsistencies, redundancies, & unnecessary repetition in statutes, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 60 days after sine die.

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
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
